Their journey through backwoods churches, backroom politics, Waffle Houses, and drunken family barbecues is uproarious to start, but will have devastating consequences.

With the keen wit of *Billy Lynn's Long Halftime Walk* and the deft argot of *The Brief Wondrous Life of Oscar Wao*, T. Geronimo Johnson has written an astonishing, razor-sharp satire.
