The South African Constitution; international agreements the country signed such as United Nations Convention against Corruption; the National Development plan; and laws such as Prevention and Combating of Corrupt Activities Act are all integrated and the power they give to Joe Public is explained

Against the silent but powerful policy background, an organization's anti-corruption program is addressed. With many examples, definitions and case studies the reader is guided to put in place preventative measures such as a code of conduct and a gift register; procedures for reporting, investigating and the hearing of corruption cases.
